

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World Book Day

Don't forget that it's **World Book Day next Thursday** (7th March). As I mentioned last week, the theme is a Mad Hatter's Tea Party. Children can come into school in non-uniform, dressed as mad as they like; this could be as simple as odd socks, or as crazy and colour clashing as children like. We ask that football kits are **NOT** worn on this day, as outfits should link to the Mad Hatter's Tea Party.

And remember that children's shoe boxes of their favourite books have to be in school on Thursday too. More and more wonderful creations have been brought into school – they really are amazing!

The Share Shed

Many of you know that we have our Share Shed at the front of school to support our families. It is open everyday and we ask families to come and help themselves to items that they need, which range from toiletries to tinned food items and food items that have a long shelf life (e.g cereal and pasta). We are starting to run low on some items and are asking if you have any items that you would like to donate, could you please bring them into school and leave them at the school office.

Boom Reader and Reading Books

We are moving to Boom Reader as a way for parents (and children) to record when children have read at home. When your child has read at home, please log in and write down which book your child has read and the page number. There is also the option for you to write a comment, you could comment on how your child has read or if they enjoyed the pages they have read. Teachers will check Boom Reader once a week and will give children a gem for each time they have read at home that week. As they accumulate gems the children will be able to use the gems to create and then change avatars!
