## Step by step guide

1

Turn on or off private mode While in a party with friends or when teamed up with random players during a match, a text chat channel becomes available. This setting controls whether or not this account can hear receive or send messages in the text chat channel Get to the menu by tapping the cog in the top-right hand corner. Tap 'Party Privacy' then choose either Public, Friends only or Private.


