Dear Parents,

Following our previous highly successful visits to London, we are pleased to be able to offer another visit to the city incorporating a theatre visit to see 'Aladdin' at the Prince Edward Theatre. This residential visit is for pupils who will be in Year 5 in the next academic year (this year's Year 4 children).

The visit will take place on Wednesday 17<sup>th</sup> and Thursday 18<sup>th</sup> October 2018. We propose to make the whole visit an experience to remember for the children, and list below our planned itinerary (subject to change).

On Wednesday 17<sup>th</sup> October we will be leaving school early in the morning (approx. 8am) and stopping 'en route' for lunch at McDonalds Northampton Services. We will then continue directly into London for our pre-booked flight on the London Eye; following this we will have a guided walking tour of some famous sights in the city before stopping to eat our packed tea (a packed tea and drinks will be required, named & wrapped in either cling film or silver foil so the rubbish can be disposed of). After tea we will make our way to the Prince Edward Theatre to see the evening performance of 'Aladdin'. The coach will then take our party directly to the 4\* Best Western Park Plus Grand Heathrow hotel for our overnight stop. Next morning following a full English breakfast buffet, the coach will take us to Harry Potter World at Watford where we will be able to discover the magic of Harry Potter; we will be having a pre-ordered packed lunch at Harry Potter World. Later that afternoon we then begin our journey home to Wakefield, stopping en-route at Northampton Services where we will have tea at McDonalds. Estimated time for us to return back to school is approximately 8pm. All provisions have been included in the final costing. More precise information about the visit will be provided nearer to the time.

The inclusive cost of this educational visit, per child, is £200.00 (subject to change depending on the number of participants). Please note, as of January 1<sup>st</sup> 2017, the governing body have determined that all academic trips for Pupil Premium children will be 50% funded by school with a request for matched 50% funding from families. This will apply to this trip. If you would like your child to participate in this educational visit, a non-refundable deposit of £50 will be required once numbers have been confirmed. Please make payment via your Parentmail account. The balance can be paid in instalments and the full amount must be paid before the visit itself.

You are invited to attend an information meeting on Thursday 27<sup>th</sup> September at 3.30pm, where further details will be given and any questions answered.

Places are limited and will be allocated on a first come first served basis. If you would like your child to participate in this unforgettable experience, please contact the school office to secure your child's place.
