## EXTRA-CURRICULAR CLUBS— CHANGE FROM JANUARY

Unfortunately, as our budget from the government reduces further year by year, we have reluctantly taken the decision to make the following changes to all internally run after school clubs from Tuesday 8th January 2019.

*'From January 2019 - all staff led after school clubs (optional extras) will be charged at £1.00 per week, payable half termly in advance of the club commencing. The cost for clubs run by outside agencies will vary and be dependent on the agency. Pupil premium children may be entitled to a 100% remission.'*

We will continue to provide the full timetable and nothing else will change. We feel that we have kept the cost to a minimum but in these times where budgets are ever reducing in schools it is necessary to take this step to ensure that we can maintain everything that we currently provide. Every little amount helps us to do this. A copy of the Charging and Remissions Policy is attached.

## ADVENTURE TRAIL

We have taken the decision to remove and replace the current adventure trail. It has been in place for over 10 years now and has received many repairs and replacements in this time. It is now proving less than financially worthwhile to undertake the increasing number of repairs and replacements and therefore have begun removing this. It is popular with the younger children, and although I cannot speak for the Parent Partnership, this could be a good target for the 2018/2019 fundraising as we aim to replace this with a new version during the course of the next twelve months.
